

Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for the Adobe Road Improvement projects in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Twentynine Palms, located at 6136 Adobe Rd, Twentynine Palms, CA 92277. The funding would be used to install permanent stormwater infrastructure to reduce flood risk and improve reliability along this key access corridor serving residents and Marine Corps Air Ground Combat Center Twentynine Palms. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will address recurring roadway flooding during rain events in a flood-prone community.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by section 203 of the Stafford Act (42 U.S.C. 5133), as amended by Section 1234, National Public Infrastructure Pre-Disaster Hazard Mitigation, of the Disaster Recovery Reform Act (DRRA) of 2018.
