

Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for the Expanding Healthcare Access to Rural Communities project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is SAC Health, located at 1003 E Brier Drive, San Bernardino CA, 92408. The funding would be used to expand and renovate the existing SAC Health clinic in Barstow, California, increasing the facility from two small 7,000 square-foot clinics to a 22,000 square-foot healthcare campus. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will increase access to primary care, behavioral health, pediatrics, women's health services, Medication Assisted Treatment and overdose prevention programs, and Enhanced Care Management teams serving low-income residents in Barstow and surrounding communities.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized under the Public Health Service Act. I certify that neither I nor my immediate family have any financial interest in this project.
