I am requesting funding for the Desert Knolls Channel Improvement Project in fiscal year 2023. The entity to receive funding for this project is San Bernardino County, located at 385 North Arrowhead Avenue, San Bernardino, California 92415.

The funding will be used to provide flood protection not only to the immediate vicinity but also to the areas downstream of the Desert Knolls Channel. The Desert Knolls Channel Improvement project is located in the Town of Apple Valley in the County of San Bernardino. The project limits are along Desert Knolls Wash, approximately 6,500 linear feet, from Apple Valley Road to Tao Road. The proposed project is an essential flood control facility that will help in providing adequate storm protection infrastructure to the Town of Apple Valley. The project is designed for a 100-year flood.
