Dear Chair DeLauro and Ranking Member Granger:

I am requesting funding for the retrofitting of Southern California Logistics Airport aircraft hangar fire-suppression foam systems containing PFAS in fiscal year 2023. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Southern California Logistics Airport, located at 18374 Phantom Street, Victorville, California 92394.

The funding will be used for retrofitting seven SCLA-owned aircraft hangar fire-suppression foam systems to meet State of California and EPA regulations regarding the use of Class B foam containing PFAS (Per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances) to new environmentally friendly fluorine-free Class B foam. The seven hangars needing these systems retrofitted all currently utilize Class B foam containing PFAS, which has come under immense focus for the adverse health effects and pollution created in the environment. This request would fall under the Environmental Protection Agency State and Tribal Assistance Grants (STAG).
