Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding to upgrade and expand the System Reliability for the Supervisory Control and Data Acquisition (SCADA) in the City of Loma Linda for Fiscal Year 2026. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Loma Linda located at 25541 Barton Rd, Loma Linda, CA 92354.

The funding would be used to install four backup power generators at critical well sites and booster stations. Moreover, it would also be used to upgrade and expand the SCADA system, ensuring continuous, safe, and efficient water delivery through advanced control and monitoring of pumps, valves, and water treatment in real-time. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because the city has faced continuous power grid shut offs, making reliable water service to the city difficult.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by Section 1452 of the Safe Drinking Water Act, 42 U.S.C. 300j-12.
