Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for the Wildwood Canyon Interchange project in Fiscal Year 2026. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Yucaipa, located at 34272 Yucaipa Blvd. Yucaipa, CA 92399.

The funding would be used to establish a new interchange connection on Interstate 10 (I-10) at Wildwood Canyon Road, between the Live Oak Canyon Road/Oak Glen Road Interchange and the County Line Road Interchange in Yucaipa, San Bernardino County, California. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will facilitate more efficient movement of goods within the I-10 corridor by improving connectivity and increasing multi-modal access for motorists and for residents within the City of Yucaipa.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by 23 USC 133.
